I’m always striving to create the perfect balance in form, color, light and movement.

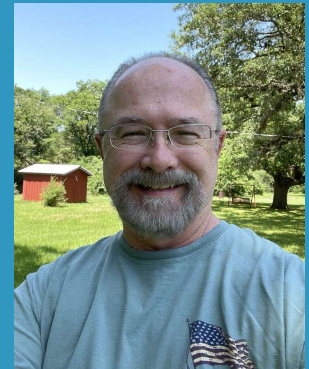
